FOSS Club (FOSS cell) of ICFOSS has been established in LBS College of Engineering, to provide the use of FOSS technologies and application among students and faculties and also to encourage them to contribute toward the community development of FOSS. The activities of the club are organized with participation of ICFOSS through a group of interested teachers and students.

FOSS clubs have been set up to conduct various programmes including training and capacity building, lectures, seminars, conferences, exhibitions, hackathons, student projects etc. within the institution or in association with other colleges/ institutions/ICFOSS. ICFOSS has been conducting events to promote Free and Open-Source Solution, in the field of OpenIoT/Hardware, Assistive Technology, Language Technology, Open Drone and GIS etc. and support the FOSS club in conducting events in the above fields. As per the direction from ICFOSS, LBS College of Engineering, Kasaragod introduced the FLOSS (Free libre open-source software) Club in 2016 to show the importance of Open-source software and its importance as academic tools. Dr. Sarith Divakar M is officiating as the current coordinator of FLOSS Club in our Institute.

The FLOSS Club at LBS have been actively conducting many activities so far such as workshops and technical events such as article writings, paper presentation competitions etc. The FLOSS Club at our college operates mainly on the primary principle of mentorship where the senior members of the club individually mentor juniors and the club as such acts as a community where each one helps the other one out. The club motivates students to contribute to open-source projects of various popular open-source organizations, work on developing projects aimed at solving real-world problems, participate in open-source student programs, attend national and international developer meets, conferences, hackathons and so on.
