I. Applications are invited from qualified candidates for permanent appointment to the post of Assistant Professor in the Department of Computer Science and Engineering/Information Technology at LBS College of Engineering, Kasaragod, established by the LBS Centre for Science and Technology, Palayam, Thiruvananthapuram. Details regarding the name of the post, scale of pay, probable number of vacancies, and required qualifications are as shown below.

III. Age Limit

Candidate shall be within the age limit of 20 to 39 as on 01/01/2025. The maximum age limit shall be raised by 5 years for SC/ST candidates and 3 years for OBC candidates. Differently-abled candidates and Ex-servicemen candidates are also eligible for relaxation in upper age limit as per rules, subject to the condition that in no case the maximum age limit shall exceed 50 years.

IV. Last Date of Application

The last date and time of submitting online application shall be **30.07.2025 up to 12** midnight and online payment shall be **31.07.2025 up to 12** midnight.

V. General Conditions regarding submission of applications

- Applications shall be submitted online to the Director, LBS Centre for Science and Technology, Palayam, Thiruvananthapuram, available through the official website of the Centre (www.lbscentre.kerala.gov.in). Only online applications will be accepted.
- 2) The application fee shall be Rs.1,500/- for General candidates and Rs.750/- for candidates belonging to SC/ST Communities/Eligible Differently abled candidates. The mode of payment shall be through online only. Cash/DD/Money Order/Cheque etc. will not be accepted. The application fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 3) Candidates employed in Central Government/ State Government/ Public Undertaking/ Autonomous Bodies etc. shall obtain a certificate from the head of the Institution stating that the candidate shall be relieved from the Institution if selected. This should be submitted on demand.
- 4) All the applicants will be admitted provisionally for the examination. The original documents to prove qualifications, date of birth, community, disability etc. have to be produced for verification as and when called for. The applications of candidates without required educational qualifications and who are found not within the prescribed age limit, on verification will be rejected.
- 5) All the original documents to prove claims of reservations and relaxation in upper age limit shall be produced at the time of certificate verification.
- 6) Candidates who claim equivalent qualification instead of qualification mentioned in the notification shall produce the relevant Government Order/Equivalency Certificate from Institution concerned to prove the equivalency at the time of certificate verification, then only such qualification shall be treated as equivalent to the prescribed qualification.
- 7) In the case of difference in original Caste/Community claimed in the application and that entered in SSLC book, the candidate shall produce a Gazette Notification in this regard, along with Non Creamy Layer Certificate / Community Certificate at the time of certificate verification.
- 8) Communication to Candidates: All notifications and updates regarding the recruitment process, including exam schedules, admit cards, interview dates, and final results, will be published on the official website of LBS Centre for Science and Technology. Candidates are advised to check the website regularly. No separate communication will be sent via post.

VI. General Conditions of Appointment

- 1) All candidates must submit a duly signed undertaking, in the prescribed format available on the website of the LBS Centre for Science and Technology, along with their application. By submitting this undertaking, the candidate affirms their unconditional commitment to serve at LBS College of Engineering, Kasaragod, for the entirety of their service tenure, if appointed. Failure to comply with this condition at any stage will be treated as a serious breach of terms and may lead to cancellation of appointment or other appropriate action.
- Upper age limit shall be relaxed for such candidates entitled to the same as allowed to similar candidates seeking appointment by direct recruitment through the Kerala Public Service Commission.
- 3) Candidates applying for the post should have attained the prescribed qualifications on or before the closing date of online submission of application.
- 4) Reservation: Appointments will be made in accordance with the rules of reservation and roster system as prescribed by the Government of Kerala. Candidates claiming reservation under SC/ST/OBC or other eligible categories must produce valid community and non-creamy layer certificates (where applicable) at the time of verification.
- 5) Disqualification: Candidates furnishing false or incomplete information, or found to have suppressed material facts, will be disqualified at any stage of the selection process. If such instances are discovered after appointment, appropriate disciplinary/legal action will be initiated, including termination of service.
- 6) The notified designation, scale of pay and other benefits regarding Assistant Professor are liable to be modified/enhanced as and when decided to be allowed by the Governing Body of LBS Centre for Science and Technology/ Government in accordance with the AICTE/UGC norms.
- 7) The benefits which are not claimed in the submitted online application form will not be considered later.

VII. Method of Selection

The selection will be based on a rank list prepared after conducting an objective-type test (OMR-based), interview, and/or proficiency test, as applicable. Details regarding the post and the selection process will be published on the official website of the LBS Centre for Science and Technology in due course. Appointments from the rank list will be made strictly in accordance with the rules and procedures followed by the Kerala Public Service Commission. No TA/DA will be paid for the tests/Interview.

VIII. Validity of Rank Lists

Rank list shall be valid for a minimum period of 2 (Two) years and maximum period of 3 (Three) years from the date of publication of the respective list.

IX. Mode of submitting the Online Applications.

- Candidates can apply through online from "www.lbscentre.kerala.gov.in."
- A valid mobile number is required for online registration for sending the registration details/ instructions.
- Candidate should upload his/her recent passport size photograph (taken within 3 months) and signature.
- Candidates should upload relevant certificates to prove their educational qualifications and claims for reservations.
- Application fee will be collected through online mode only.
- After registration, candidates are advised to keep the printout of the application, Registration ID and Site Access Key for future reference.
- The application will be summarily rejected if non-compliance with the notification is found in due course of processing.
- The date of availability of admission ticket and the date of examination will be published in the LBS Website. Candidates need to download the admission ticket for the test through online mode only. No admission ticket will be sent to the candidates individually by post. Candidates are advised to visit LBS Website occasionally for further information.
- The printout of the application may be retained by the candidate for future reference. No need to send the printout to LBS Centre.
- LBS Centre reserves the right to cancel or postpone the process at any stage of the recruitment.
