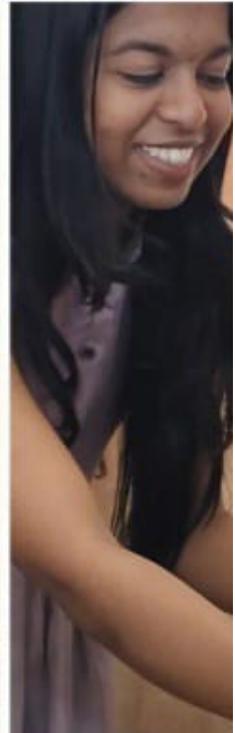
❖ Innovation Corner tech fest

Event Description:

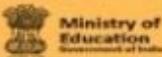

- Active participation from students

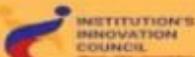
